News from Peter and Kay Goodchild at Emmanuel Press in South Africa



Hello again. We are now already well in to our third month in South Africa! We thought it appropriate to tell you a little of Emmanuel Press' history in order to set the scene for our mission of discovery and doing here in White River.

Emmanuel Press was founded after the Canadian linguist Charles Austin Chawner met the English engineer Hubert Phillips in 1928. Hubert owned a small hand press capable of printing 6"x4" sheets and together they started printing all sorts of Christian literature from a small Shingwedzi mud hut.

Since then Emmanuel Press has been staffed by Canadian & British missionaries along with a team of local Africans. Over the years, millions of Gospel tracts sharing the love of God and inviting readers to enrol in a 14 lesson Basic Christian Discipleship correspondence course have been posted out. Postal responses peaked in the late 20th century as hundreds of thousands enrolled for these simple yet powerful courses. And, all of these ABSOLUTELY FREE! Some of you will remember David & Loreen Newington who pioneered that amazing chapter.

The picture today is vastly different; we are down to just hundreds of responses each month. With the turbulent political scene in South Africa, the postal service has taken a big hit, and for The Press that has been devastating. Today most of the post is terribly delayed or never makes it through. Last November in the UK I posted a Christmas card to the EP director. It finally arrived here a couple of weeks ago, in late April! Sadly, tired workers became discouraged, wondering where to go from



here. It's been almost an 'emergency landing' feel as we arrived on the scene.

Johannes Gutenberg's invention of the printing press brought about a communication revolution in the 1400's. Similarly, the development of the internet has birthed a dramatic change since the The Press's historic high.

So, the challenge is before us... Millions of our 'target audience' have access to the internet, yet there are still millions who don't. We need strategies to reach them all. For the moment, we
