August witnessed a significant milestone for our longest serving team member here at The Press. Calvin Khoza began his involvement when David and Loreen Newington were at the helm in the eighties! On 16th August it was celebration time as we thanked God and Calvin for FORTY faithful years of helping to bring God's written Word to multiplied thousands. It was a delight as we blessed God, and presented Calvin with a certificate, a beautiful Zulu Bible and a special envelope. Calvin has run the Comrades ultramarathon for 28years, but his EP race is FORTY years and still running. Thanks be to God for faithfulness demonstrated over *this* race. 2 Tim. 4:7-8

Also in August we received a phone call from a former student, Samuel. He received our lessons in prison in the year 2000. Whilst studying the courses he repented of his sin, surrendered his life to Jesus Christ and began sharing the Gospel with other inmates. 23 years later he phoned to say "thank you" to EP for all that we do and to encourage us: "the course turned my life around" and "you have touched more lives than you know." Samuel was released from prison in 2003 and started witnessing to those he met and is now travelling across Africa holding evangelistic crusades and seeing many come to the Lord and many healed. Praise The LORD!

So to conclude, we thank God for His purposes from here. The faithful team of office workers supplying simple teaching for those 'in the field' are united, busy and committed. We now have almost 100 different lessons, and requests for further studies continue.

Please pray for more workers in the field to carry GOD's life-giving Word to schools, prisons, communities, churches, both here in SA and in other countries... wherever God leads. Our race is still on, and we want to run well until Jesus returns.
